Scholarship Checklist



- Contact Julie Simpson, Director of Admissions, to register as a scholarship applicant
- Student applicant should compose and submit a 1-2 page paper supporting his/her Scholarship quest.
 - Paper should be addressed to Calverton's Scholarship Committee / Mrs. Simpson
 - Paper should state why he/she should be awarded a scholarship from The Calverton School
 - Send paper to Julie Simpson, Director of Admissions, The Calverton School by **January 14th**
- Three letters of recommendation submitted by **January 14th**
 - Applicant should demonstrate exemplary character evidenced through three high character references from individuals not related to the student and also display strong academic excellence.
 - Applicant must be committed to involvement in extracurricular or co-curricular activities and demonstrate a strong commitment to attend college upon graduation.
 - Student must exemplify strong academic excellence
- ***ALL STUDENTS APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIP MUST APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID***
- Complete the Financial Aid package
 - Financial aid packages are available through the Admissions Office or the Business Office
 - Adherence to deadline dates is *imperative*
 - **January 31**, Submit financial aid application online through Financial Aid for School Tuition (F.A.S.T.). There is a link on Calverton's website at www.calvertonschool.org. See FAST button at the bottom left margin of the home page.
 - **February 15**, Due to Financial Aid for School Tuition (F.A.S.T.) Copies of 2008 final paycheck, 2008 W-2's, 2008 Federal and State tax returns, 1098s, and 1099's
